Dazhou Shiban Coal Line

This line south of Dazhou serves a power station at Shiban. The coal comes from a mine just under the G65 expressway south east of Shiban.

We transferred from Wangcang in the morning and arrived to find the rails on this 762 mm electric line bright yellow with rust with no sign of any trains. After lunch, things improved.



We found No. 6 at the power station end from where it took some wagons back to the depot which is in the middle of nowhere. We managed to drive there with a short hike up to the line but were turned away with 'no access, no photography' spelt out loud and clear by a young and officious employee.

We retreated to the big bridge close to the mine but rain and murk made it challenging photographically.



When the rain cleared, No. 2 crossed the bridge will 11 empties.
